

Fact Sheet: Lower Ninth Ward Neighborhood Road Repairs

Project Summary:

The City of New Orleans will implement a multi-million dollar, multi-year comprehensive infrastructure improvement program to repair Hurricane Katrina related sub-surface and road damages. Types of repairs deemed eligible for improvement by FEMA include utilities, sidewalks, American with Disabilities Act compliant ramps, driveway aprons, curbs and road paving.

Project Facts:

Phase I: Between 2008-2009, the City of New Orleans performed citywide repairs to approximately 17,000 damage sites at an estimated cost of \$55.2M. Completed repairs in the Lower Ninth Ward totaled approximately \$2.2 million.

Phase II: The Lower Ninth Ward Recovery Roads program will include multiple construction repair projects with a total estimated value of approximately \$42 million for roadway improvements. Construction of Deslonde, Flood and Lizardi streets from N. Claiborne Ave. to Florida Ave. is scheduled to begin in February 2013 and will last through Fall 2013. Design of other future road repair work in Quadrant 1, 2 and 3 is currently underway and is being closely coordinated with the Sewerage and Water Board of New Orleans. Road resurfacing work will be limited in some areas of Lower Ninth Ward.

What to expect during construction:

Residents and businesses in the Lower Ninth Ward should exercise caution when driving, bicycling or walking near active construction sites. Residents can expect to experience temporary construction inconveniences such as limited access to areas within the construction zones, detours, movement of heavy equipment, safety signage and sounds.

Neel Schaffer, Inc., IMS Engineers and HNTB are currently designing road improvements in the Lower Ninth Ward.

Construction of Deslonde, Flood and Lizardi streets from N. Claiborne Ave. to Florida Ave. will be performed by Barriere Construction, Co. and Plus Concrete. In general, construction crews will be working from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday.

Construction contracts for work in Quadrant 1, 2 and 3 are scheduled for award in the summer and late 2013.


